



Private Pilot License



A Private Pilot License (PPL) allows you to fly an aircraft on your own for recreational purposes.

You can also legally share the aircraft hiring cost with your passengers, however you cannot fly for hire or reward unless you have a commercial pilot license.

Prior to enrollment, all that is needed is a third class medical exam with a designated aviation medical examiner and be at least 17 years of age.

Course Dates

Our Private Pilot course is conducted year round. Please contact us for upcoming course start dates.

Course Duration

The Private Pilot License course can be completed on a full time basis in approximately 6-8 weeks. This time frame is dependent on variables, such as weather conditions and student aptitude.

Aircraft

JFS operates the Cessna 150 aircraft for the PPL course. Other aircraft are available on request.

Course Components

Courses consist of two major components: Flight and Knowledge areas.

Flying

Prior to the flight test, the following JFS syllabus hours and exams must be complete:

- 20 hours dual flying
- 15 hours solo flying
- 35 hour ground school
- 5 stage exams & 1 pre-solo exam
- FAA computerized test• FAA computerized test
