The Professional Pilot Course is designed for a career oriented flight student starting with zero experience and graduating with the following licenses and ratings under FAA 141:

- Commercial Pilot License-*Airplane*
- Instrument Rating- *Airplane*
- Single and Multi-Engine Land Class Ratings

Prior to enrollment, all that is needed is a second class medical exam with a designated aviation medical examiner and be at least 18 years of age.

Course Dates

Course Duration

Our Professional Pilot Course can be completed in 8-10 months.

Aircraft

JFS operates multiple Cessna and Beechcraft aircraft for the Professional Pilot Course.

Course Components

Course consists of two major components: Flight and Knowledge areas.

Flying

Prior to graduation, the following JFS syllabus hours and exams must be complete:

- 143 hours dual flying
- 105 hours solo flying
- 105 hour ground school
- 16 stage exams and 1 pre-solo exam
