



# Tailwheel Endorsement



A Tailwheel Endorsement allows you to act as pilot-in-command of an aircraft with conventional landing gear or "Tailwheel".

### Course Dates

Our Tailwheel training is conducted year round. Please contact us for upcoming course start dates and availability.

### Course Duration

The Tailwheel Endorsement can typically be accomplished in 1-2 days.

### Aircraft

JFS operates the Cessna 140 aircraft for our Tailwheel training.

### Course Components

Courses consist of two major components: Flight and Knowledge areas. Specific subject areas include:

- Tailwheel Basics
- Aircraft Systems
- Cockpit Familiarization
- Hand Propping/Starting Techniques
- Performance Considerations
- Aircraft Ground Operations/Characteristics
- Flight Maneuvers
- Takeoffs/Landings-Wheel & Three Point

### Flying

Prior to the endorsement, the following training must be complete:

- dual flying to show proficiency (5-8 hours average)
- 2 hour ground school
